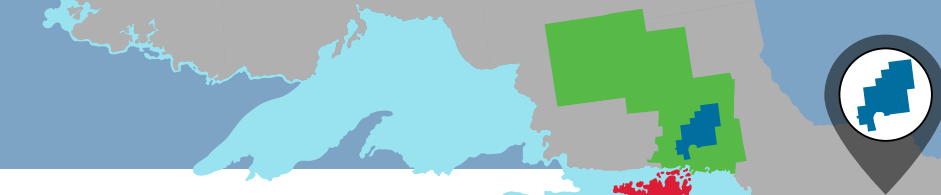

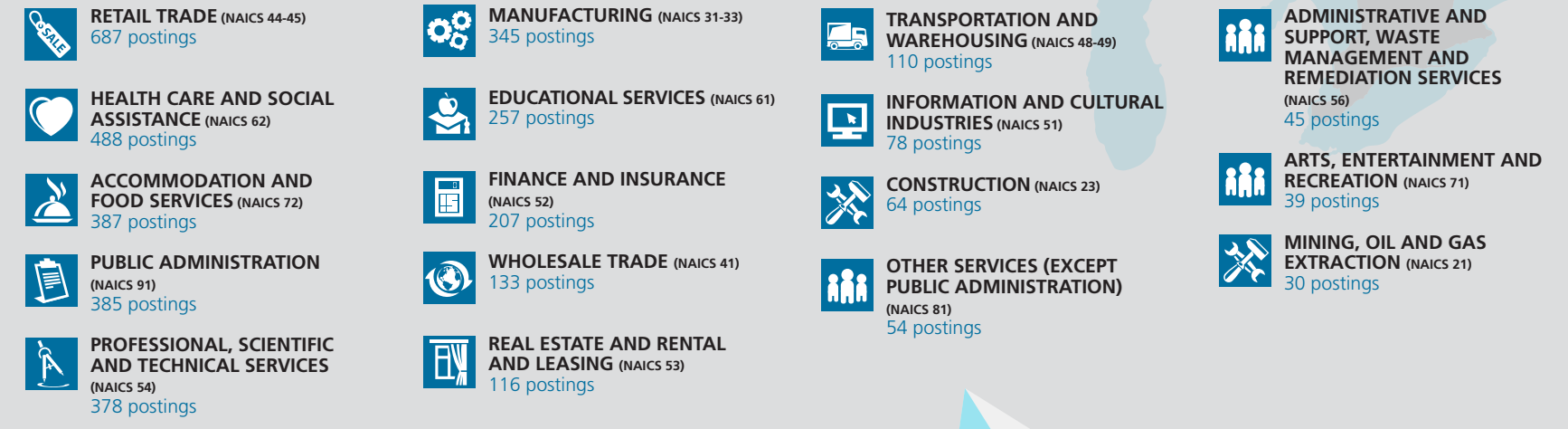

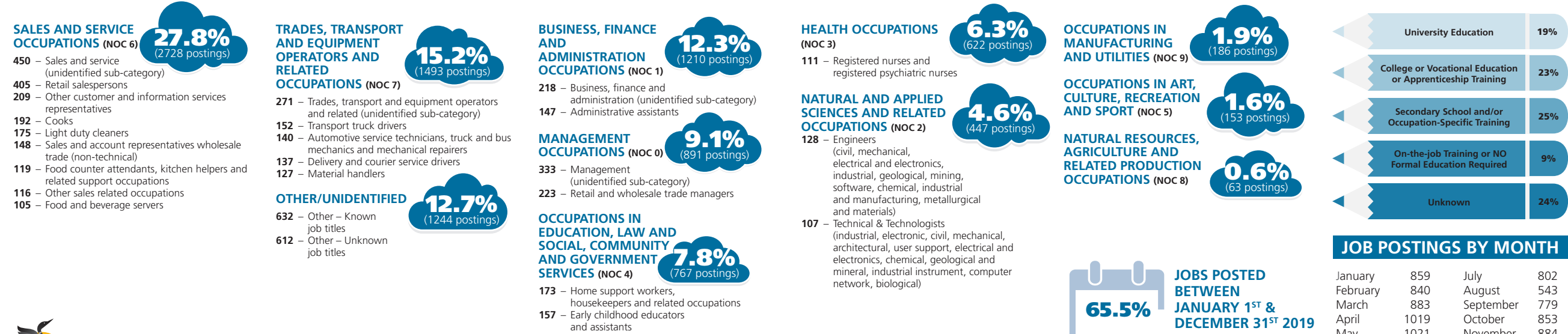
INDUSTRIES BY # OF JOB POSTINGS

(by NAICS - North American Industry Classification System and includes industries with 25+ job postings)

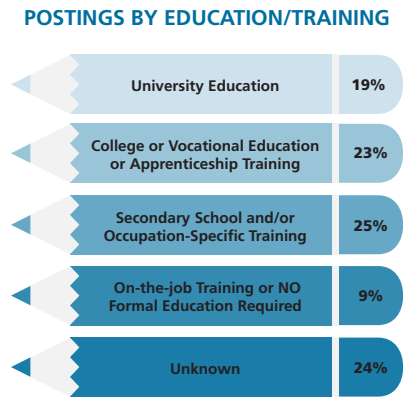


POSTINGS BY OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORIES (50 OR MORE POSTINGS BY OCCUPATION)

(by NOC – National Occupational Classification code)

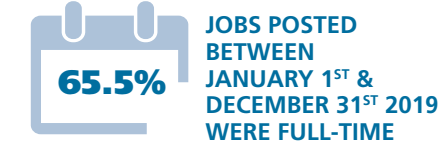

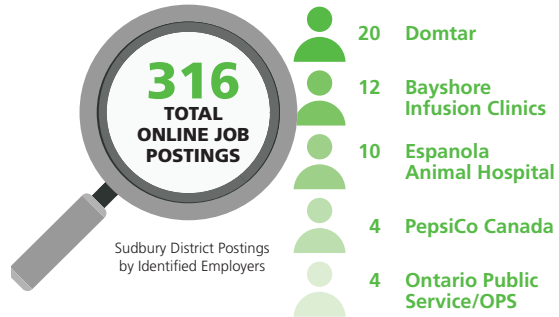

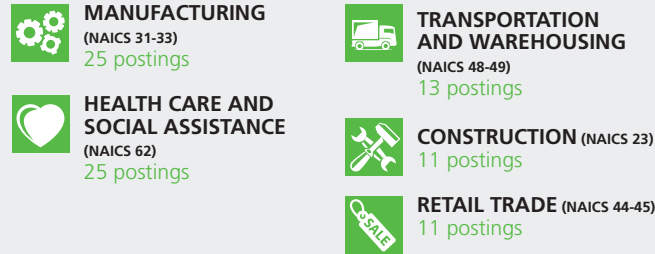


Sudbury District Postings by Identified Employers

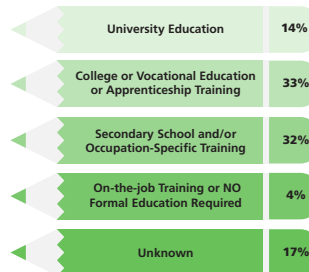

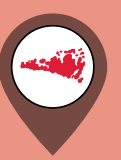

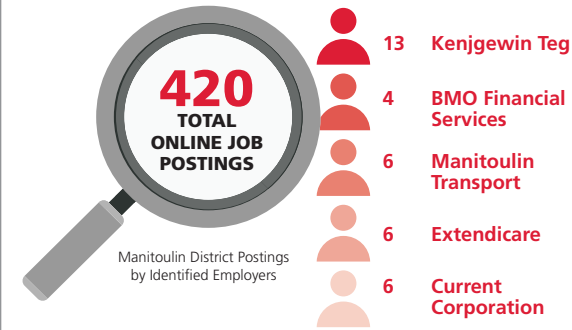

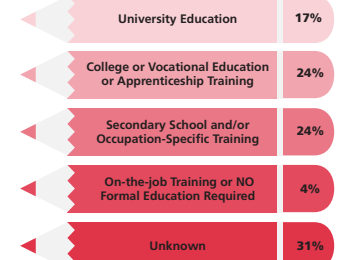
